MARKET INSIGHT BY UBS

After the rally—where do we stand?

The news headlines on the spread of the virus remain challenging. The global tally of confirmed cases has risen past 720,000, of which the US now accounts for nearly a fifth. Over the weekend, an influential advisor to President Trump warned the US death toll could climb as high as 200,000, and President Trump extended national social distancing guidelines through 30 April. Officials from Germany, Spain and Italy called for a more tightly coordinated European response, and Spain was among those ordering more stringent mobility restrictions as its daily death toll rose to a record 838 on Sunday. A deceleration in the growth rate of cases in Italy offered some signs of hope that lockdown strategies can contain the spread of the virus, even if the medical emergency is likely to continue to escalate in the days and weeks ahead across much of Europe and the US.
